### Week 2: Prayer for Revival in our Families

Throughout this time of prayer and fasting as a congregation we will be focusing on different areas of prayer for revival. In this 2nd week we will focus on praying for revival in our families. We are living in a culture and time when families and marriages are under attack from every side. God’s desire is for the family to bring Him glory, reflect His character and to be a witness for the gospel to a lost and dying world. The enemy is seeking to disrupt God’s purpose for the family through his schemes of division and lies. Let us join together in praying and asking the Lord for repentance, salvation, restoration and healing in our families.

We turn from our ways and choose to seek You with all our hearts. Let our hearts be softened and bring the rain of Your righteousness in our lives. We ask that You bring the refreshing and outpouring of Your Spirit on our family. Lord, open the eyes of the hearts of prodigals and unsaved loved ones and</i></p>

			<i>remove the veil of darkness from their minds so that they may sense their need for You and return to Your house. In the mighty name of JESUS, AMEN!"</i>
<b>Sunday 6/13</b>	Forgiveness	<i>Psalm 79:9 Psalm 86:5 Mark 11:25-26 John 20:23 Ephesians 4:32 Colossians 3:13-14 1 John 1:9</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Confessing our sins one to another and against other family members; receiving God's forgiveness.</li> <li>• Forgiving one another for past offenses.</li> </ul> <p><i>Prayer: "Lord, we thank You that You are good, and ready to forgive, and abundant in lovingkindness to all who call upon You. We confess that we have not always treated our family members kindly, and in doing so, we have grieved the Holy Spirit. We ask that You forgive us and cleanse us from all unrighteousness. Help us to put away bitterness, wrath, anger and malice, and to be kind, tenderhearted and forgiving to one another as a family. In Jesus name, amen."</i></p>
<b>Monday 6/14</b>	Reconciliation and healing	<i>Isaiah 58:12 Matthew 5:22-24 Luke 4:18-19 2 Corinthians 5:18-21 Hebrews 12:14</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Asking the Lord to repair any breaches between family members</li> <li>• Asking our family members for forgiveness for any offense we may have caused and praying for reconciliation.</li> <li>• Prayer for unsaved family members to be reconciled to God.</li> <li>• Healing of hurts, wounds, effects of abuse and dysfunction in families.</li> <li>• Healing of broken marriages.</li> </ul> <p><i>Prayer: "Father we thank You for Your love for us and for our families. We acknowledge that you are Jehovah Rapha – the Lord Who heals. You bind up the broken hearts. You give us beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for our mourning. You make all things new. We ask You bring healing to every broken family and marriage and that You repair breaches in relationships between family members. We thank You that You have reconciled us to Yourself through Christ and have given our family the ministry of reconciliation. Help us to be those who bring healing and minister peace and reconciliation to others around us so that we may be a testimony to Your love and mercy in this world. In the wonderful name of Jesus, AMEN."</i></p>

		<p><i>Malachi 4:5-6</i> <i>1 Cor 3:11</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Restoring biblical foundations in our homes, teaching scriptural principles</li> <li>• Restoring relationships between parents and children</li> </ul> <p>Prayer: <i>“Lord, center our families and our homes on Your love for us, growing in us a great love for You. Help us build, restore and strengthen the bond between fathers (parents) and their children, between husbands and wives. We do not want the earth to be cursed, and we seek and desire your blessing. <p><b>Wednesday 6/16</b></p>	<p>Unity</p>	<p><i>Psalm 86:11</i> <i>Psalm 133</i> <i>1 Corinthians 1:10</i> <i>Ephesians 4:1-3</i> <i>Colossians 2:1-3</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Prayer that families may live together in unity and harmony and that the Lord would command a blessing on our homes.</li> <li>• Praying against divisive schemes of the devil to destroy our families.</li> <li>• Praying for the unity of the Spirit and bond of peace in our homes.</li> </ul> <p>Prayer: <i>“Lord, we humbly ask You to help us as a family to stay in unity, uniting our hearts in the fear of God. We recognize that we don’t battle against one another, but against spiritual forces that want to divide us. As a family we come against and cancel the schemes of the enemy to divide us and turn us against each other. We ask that, by Your grace Lord, you would knit our hearts together in love and help us to endeavor to keep your peace and the unity of the Spirit as a family. In Jesus name, AMEN!”</i></p>
<p><b>Thursday 6/17</b></p>	<p>Gospel witness, fruitfulness</p>	<p><i>Joel 2:28-29</i> <i>Matt 5:13-16</i> <i>John 15:5</i> <i>Colossians 1:9-12</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Outpouring of the Holy Spirit on our families and manifestation of His gifts in our lives</li> <li>• Being salt and light in our households and in the world.</li> <li>• Abiding in the Lord and fruitfulness</li> </ul> <p>Prayer: <i>“Lord, may your kingdom come into our homes and the heart of our family. May our family be everything you want it to be and may it bring glory to You, Your Name, and Your Kingdom. Pour out Your Spirit on our sons and daughters to see visions and prophesy. Make our homes and our families to be lighthouses in our neighborhoods. Help us to express your love and righteousness in ways others can see and</i></p>

			<i>glorify You. Help us as a family to continually abide in You and live fruitful lives for Your glory and praise."</i>
<b>Friday 6/18</b>	Strength, endurance, perseverance and protection	<i>Psalm 5:11 Psalm 28:7 Isaiah 40:29-31 Romans 15:1-4 2 Thessalonians 3:3 Hebrews 10:35-36 1 Peter 5:10</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Strengthening of our families to continue to persevere and not grow weary in well doing.</li> <li>• Protection over families from any devices of the enemy – sickness, disease, accidents, etc.</li> <li>• Endurance in faith through trials and times of testing.</li> </ul> <p><i>Prayer: "Lord, You are our strength and shield. You are an ever-present help to us in times of trouble. Our trust is in You, and we will wait on You. We ask You would strengthen and refresh us and other families who may be growing weary. Help us to endure in faith during times of testing, trials and shaking and not throw away our confidence in You. Lead us not into temptation and deliver us from the evil one. Help us to overcome and be more than conquerors through Your love and Your power, in Your precious and mighty Name!"</i></p>
